

## VENTEC EDUCATION MODULES FOR RESPIRATORY THERAPISTS- 2.0 AARC CEUs

Early in the initial wave of the COVID-19 Pandemic, Ventec Life Systems partnered with General Motors (GM) to build 1 ventilator with 6 different configurations. The ventilator was designed by Ventec Life Systems and built by GM as part of Operation Warp Speed. These ventilators can be used in hospitals with a full array of modes and therapies. There are models for home use with a limited number of therapies dependent on the needs of the patient.

V+O+C+S+N stands for ventilator, oxygen, cough assist, suction and nebulizer. This ventilator is designed to perform all these functions in one small portable machine. The V+Pro is another ventilator by Ventec. It is a ventilator but does not provide therapy modalities. It runs off high-pressure external oxygen with FiO2 monitoring or low-pressure external oxygen.

The Ventecs are compact and easy to use. The machine offers all the standard modes of ventilation, including CPAP, BiPAP and Hi-flow nasal oxygen therapy. The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) has a cache of V+C+S+N+Pro ventilators and V+Pro for immediate deployment if needed in a medical surge incident requiring ventilatory support.

A series of 13 videos addressing the features of the VOCSN, a Clinician Assessment plus Knowledge Check are available for training. The videos range in length from 49 seconds to 19 minutes.
