


## VENTEC VENTILATOR OVERVIEW FOR NURSES

There is 1 CEU nursing overview of the Ventec VOCSN ventilator. VOCSN stands for ventilator, oxygen, cough assist, suction and nebulizer. This ventilator is designed to perform all these functions in one small portable machine. The ventilator was designed by Ventec Life Systems and built by General Motors (GM) as part of Operation Warp Speed.

It is a compact and easy to use machine that offers all the standard modes of ventilation, including CPAP, BiPAP and Hi-flow nasal oxygen therapy. The video shows all the functions and modes of ventilation the machine can provide.

### MI-TRAIN – Create an account:

To create an account on MI-TRAIN, log-in to the following link: <https://www.train.org/mi-train/welcome>. On the left-hand side of the page, you will see the box as shown to the left. Click on *Create an Account*. Follow the instructions, including creating a profile with all the required information (\*). **Do not hit the back button at any time during the registration process.** Answer the secret question at the bottom of the page with an easily recallable, one-word answer.

### Register for a Course:

Go to the MI-TRAIN website: <https://www.train.org/mi-train/welcome>. Enter your log-in name and password, click on the log-in box. At the top right of the page, in the box that says Keyword or Course ID, type in the Course ID (in this case 1097996) then click on the magnifying glass. Next click on the Registration Tab.

Go to <https://www.train.org/mi-train/welcome>. Click on the Forgot Your Log-in Name/Password? Link. Enter the email address you used when you created your account and click the Send Password and Log-in Name button. Your password and log-in name will be sent via email.
