New Business	 Long Distance Transport AAR Review and Wrap Up Still waiting on a few partners to send in invoices and After-Action items. Luke will try to complete AAR for coalition meeting on Thursday, will try to send out a copy ahead of time. Preliminary report is that communications and loading of patient into back of ambulance by nonems personnel will be talking points. Funding Radios for SPRN Transport Team? During the event we used 800 MHz radios to communicate through the MCC. One of the ideas that was presented to this group is should we fund 10 portable radios that would be specific cache for SPRN transport teams. Discussion took place. Radio Quote is for just under \$2500, this would cover just the radio, would also like to get throat mic and ear bud to allow to stay in PPE. Suggestion to add on to 800 MHz project to allow for best pricing. Price of radio includes initial programming and shipping. Estimating \$25,000 total on project. - o Reviewed the status of current cache that we have, the green rubber hoods are out of date and are not able to be certified by 3M.
- Discussion took place about what direction do we want to go, should we get items that cover CBRNE response? Discussion took place about what system to move forward with, recommended to not go with the breathe easy for sustainability purposes. Discussion took place about concerns for sustainment for any item we move forward with.
- o 2 options were presented and discussed. Group is leaning towards going with purchasing full suits (new ones) for hospitals. This would be CBRNE rated instead of Max Air.
 - Need to get quotes to see what we can afford.
 - Luke estimates that we have \$175,000
 - Ken getting quote for 144 full ensembles, that would allow 6 for each hospital.
- o Training for other options outside of breathe easy will be very similar. Discussion took place.
