BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Region 6 Healthcare Coalition

The Region 6 Healthcare Coalition is a 13 county emergency preparedness program that collaborates with Hospitals, EMS, Long Term Care, Public Health, and Emergency Management to coordinate medical services during natural and man-made disasters. These counties include Clare, Ionia, Isabella, Kent, Lake, Mason, Mecosta, Montcalm, Muskegon, Newaygo, Oceana, Osceola, and Ottawa. The West Michigan Regional Medical Consortium (WMRMC) is the fiduciary for the Region 6 Healthcare Coalition and is the contracting agency for this proposal.

STATEMENT OF NEED

The purpose of this Request for Proposal (RFP) is to solicit proposals from qualified National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians (NAEMT) training providers who have the capacity to deliver multiple Tactical Emergency Casualty Care (TECC) courses to a minimum of 30 EMS practitioners and other prehospital providers per class across Michigan's Region 6. This target group consists of licensed providers from Medical First Responders, Emergency Medical Technician Basics, Emergency Medical Technician Specialists, Paramedics, Registered Nurses, and Physicians. All training must be delivered prior to June 1, 2020.

BID PROCESS

When submitting a proposal, potential vendors must provide documentation from NAEMT they are a certified training provider of the Tactical Emergency Casualty Care (TECC) curriculum and will conduct all education in accordance with NAEMT policies and procedures for administration of the course. At a minimum, the Proposal shall include:

- 1. Organizational Background: provide a brief description of your organization
- 2. **Experience / Qualifications**: provide a brief history of the organization, its size, and experience with delivering NAEMT education and the TECC curriculum
- 3. Capacity to provide service: describe the following
 - a. Expected student to instructor ratio
 - b. Short description of instructors assign to this project including their relevant experience
 - c. Number of proposed deliveries to train a minimum 30 students
 - d. Proposed location(s) across Region 6 where training(s) will be delivered
 - e. Proposed course registration process
- 4. **Training Content:** provide a sample course plan for participants
- 5. **Budget and Cost Effectiveness:** list training fees, registration cost per student, costs for student materials, and estimated travel expenses if separate from training fee for a total cost per training.
- 6. **References:** please attach references including names, organization, and contact information for three (3) clients who can provide insights regarding skills, qualification, and delivery of requested training services.

Right to Reject

The Region 6 Healthcare Coalition and WMRMC reserve the right to reject any or all proposals or any part of the same: to award a contract(s) other than to the lowest bid, and to use the accepted bid as the basis and point of departure for final contract negotiations; to waive irregularities and/or informalities; and make any decisions which the Healthcare Coalition or WMRMC deem to be in their own best interest.

Administrative Requirements

The selected vendor must sign and return all contracts to the Region 6 Healthcare Coalition/WMRMC within ten (10) days of the receipt of the contract.

All invoices and supporting documentation must be submitted within thirty (30) days of the contract end date. Failure to do so may result in non-payment.

EVALUATION

Proposal Evaluation Criteria

All proposals will be reviewed and rated by a Region 6 Healthcare Coalition and WMRMC review team. Incomplete proposals or proposals that fail to follow the submission guidelines will not be considered for review. Proposals may be judged non-responsive and removed from further consideration if any of the following occur:

- 1. The proposal is not received timely in accordance with the terms of this RFP.
- 2. The proposal does not follow the specified format.
- 3. The proposal is not adequate to form a judgment by the reviewers.

- 20 Experience and Qualification
- 30 Capacity to Provide Service
- 10 Training Content
- 30 Cost and Sustainability
